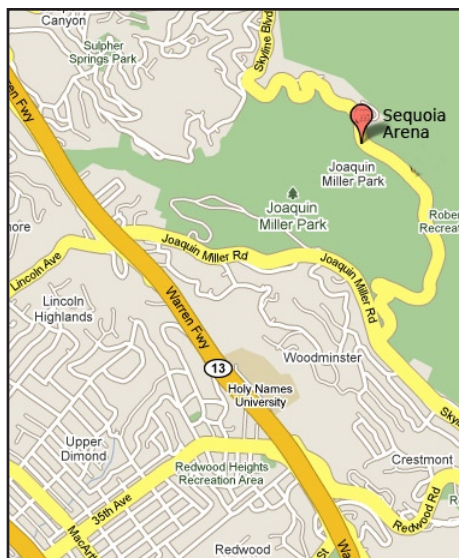

Directions to Sequoia Arena

From Highway 13 in Oakland, exit Lincoln Avenue/Joaquin Miller Rd. Follow the signs to the Chabot Space and Science Center. Go east (uphill) on Joaquin Miller Rd. to the traffic light at Skyline Blvd. Turn left onto Skyline Blvd. and go uphill into the park, about 1.1 miles. Turn left at the sign for Sequoia Arena. There will be a parking attendant to give you instructions for parking your rig.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- This show is for all Miniature Horses and Ponies up to 46". We will operate on the honor system; horses and ponies will not be measured. Horses and ponies need not be registered.
- The show begins at 9:00 a.m. Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. Please be sure to arrive early enough to register and be ready for your classes. The warm-up ring will be available beginning at 8:00 a.m.
- All exhibitors must sign a liability release. Parents or guardians must sign for youth (17 and under) exhibitors.
- Classes may be combined if less than 3 entries. This show will be held in an outdoor arena, so weather is a factor in determining if the show will be held.
- Awards: Ribbons to 6th place. High Point Miniature Horse and High Point Pony awards will be given.
- Entry Fees: \$4.95 per class, or \$25.00 flat fee for the same horse/pony and handler combination. **The flat fee is available for pre-entries only.**
- Pre-Enter: Please pre-enter by May 8. **Mail entries to Michele Nelson, 932 60th Street, Oakland, CA 94608.** Make checks payable to Metropolitan Horsemen's Association.
- Scratches will be refunded only with a certificate from a doctor or veterinarian.
- Dress: Shall be neat, clean and proper for the class you are showing in. Hard hats are required for Youth (17 years and under) in under-saddle classes.
- Trailer parking is amidst the pine trees. We will have parking assistance for you. There is no stabling available at Sequoia Arena; contact Judi Bank at (510) 531-5449 if you need overnight stabling or dry camping.
- Shallow community water troughs are available—or bring your own water buckets.
- Excellent food and beverages will be available for sale on the grounds.
- This is a City of Oakland Park; please conduct yourself accordingly. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
