ENTRY FEES: \$20.00 Per Class

POST ENTRIES: Accepted at an additional \$5.00 per class.

RULES:

1. This show is open to all registered Classic Shetland Ponies. Exhibitors will be required to provide a copy of Registrations Papers. Height of pony not to exceed 46"
2. OPEN Classes shall be open to all ponies of any breed, registered or unregistered. Height of pony not to exceed 14 Hands.
3. Breaks will be incorporated into the time schedule for tack changes and set-up and take down of ring equipment. Additional gate holds may be requested by Exhibitor to the Gate Attendant at least three (3) Classes in advance of the requested hold by the Exhibitor. Holds will be for ten (10) minutes only.
4. The Pony Show Management and / or Judges reserve the right to remove an unruly or dangerous pony from the ring and the grounds if necessary.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: (Descriptions are "generalized". Classes will be governed by Judges According to Current ASPC Rule Book).

Model Stallion - Mare – Gelding

Pony to be Judged solely on conformation and breed type. Will not be moved on the Line.

Halter Classes –

Ponies to be shown in hand at the walk and trot. Ponies must also be viewed in motion from the side. Ponies are to be shown square. (All four feet are flat on the ground). It is permissible to hand set the pony.

Showmanship Classes –

Exhibitors to be judged 100% on his/her ability to present oneself and the pony. Open to mares and geldings, any age shown at halter. Exhibitors to have complete control of pony throughout the class. Show patterns will be provided prior to class.

Classic Get of Sire - (Requires 3 Offspring)

Three Reg. Classic Shetlands – stallions, mares or geldings, the get of one Sire, any age. Judged 75% on conformation and 25% on uniformity. Will NOT be worked on a line. Combined ownership permitted. Entry is made in name of the Sire.

Class Descriptions - CONTINUED (2)

Classic Produce of Dam - (Requires 2 Offspring)

Two Reg. Classic Shetlands – stallions, mares, or geldings, the produce of one Dam, any age. (Judged as above). Entry is made in name of the Dam.

Classic Multi Color Pony –

Pony of any age, any sex of any Pinto Color Pattern: Tobeiano, Overvo, Tovero, or Sabino.
Judged 100% on Color.

Classic Solid Color Pony –

Pony of any age, any sex of any Solid Color recognized by ASPC, other than Pinto.
Judged 100% on Color.

Liberty – Ponies 1 Year and Older –

Liberty is demonstrating the natural beauty of the Shetland Pony. Ponies are to be Judged on style, grace, animation, gaits, (walk, trot, canter), presence, and ease of catching. Judging will begin when the line or halter is removed by exhibitor and until caught by the exhibitor. Time of Liberty is 1 ½ minutes. Catch time 2 minutes or under. Exhibitor may NOT use bait to catch within the 2 minute period. Music is required and will be provided by the exhibitor. Exhibitor and 1 helper only allowed in arena. Whips are allowed. Touching the pony with aids or hands will result in disqualification.

Costume – Youth and Senior Exhibitor – OPEN PONY

Costume Classes are designed to allow exhibitor to dress in coordinated costume with the pony. To be shown at a walk, both ways of the arena. Ponies may be shown In-Hand or Driven.

Lead Line: () OPEN PONY**

Equitation. Rider to be age eight and under. Leader must be 16 years of age or older. Pony to be led both ways of the ring, to lineup and stand quietly. To be Judged on rider's ability to handle and aid the pony. Mares and geldings only, NO stallions permitted.

Pony Under Saddle - Walk/Trot – Open English or Western: () OPEN PONY**

Mares or geldings only to be ridden by junior exhibitor, 10 years of age or under. To be Judged on the rail at a Walk and Trot both ways of the arena. To halt and stand quietly. To be Judged on riders ability to handle and aid the pony. Entry is made in the name of the Rider. (**) – **Riders may NOT cross enter the Lead Line and Walk Trot Classes.**

Classic Jumper In-Hand –

Course will be over six (6) Jumps no higher than 26". A Non-Timed Event. Ponies are to be Judged On accumulated faults. If a jump-off is required, it will be over the original course with fences adjusted. Exhibitors may NOT go over jumps with pony. Whips are permitted, but may NOT touch the pony. Baiting the pony to encourage jumping is NOT allowed.

Classic Halter Obstacles –

Open to ponies 2 years and older. Class to be Judged on performance and way of going with emphasis on manners throughout the course. Responsiveness and willingness to be considered. A pony can only be shown by one exhibitor per class. A handler may show more than one entry in a class. Pony to be penalized for any unnecessary delay or excessive time at an obstacle. A maximum time of sixty (60) seconds will be allowed per obstacle. Refusals do not constitute class disqualification. Cause for elimination: 1) Carrying a whip or crop. 2) Handler physically moving or coercing the pony by touching. (Handler must maneuver the pony using the lead, halter, or bridle only).

Classic Obstacle Driving –

A Timed Event. Class to be Judged on the cleanest, fastest performance. A 60 Second time will be set to complete each obstacle. After that time is used, exhibitor will be directed to the next obstacle. Refusals do NOT constitute class disqualification. **Cantering must be penalized in Obstacle Driving.**

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS - continued (3)

Classic Pleasure Driving –

Ponies are to be shown in two or four wheeled vehicles having a basket. Pony should give the appearance of a pleasurable drive, and is to be Judged on quality of performance, manners, way of going of pony, appropriateness, condition and fit of vehicle and harness, and neatness of attire in that order. Ponies to be shown both ways of the arena and Judged at a Walk, Trot, Working Trot, and Extended Trot. Ponies should stand quietly and rein back.

Classic Pleasure Driving - Limit-

Open to ponies which have not won six (6) First Place Ribbons in Class “A” or “AA” competition.

Classic Pleasure Driving Championship Stake-

Judged the same as Pleasure Driving. To qualify, ponies must have been shown in at least one (1) other class of Pleasure Driving Division in the Show now in progress.

Foundation Open Country Pleasure Driving

Judged the same as Classic Country Pleasure Driving. Pony must be registered Foundation.

Foundation Country Pleasure Driving Championship Stake

Judged the same as Classic Pleasure Driving Championship Stake. Pony must be registered Foundation.

Classic Formal Pleasure Driving To Wooden Wheeled Vehicle

Classic Country Pleasure Driving-

Pony to be shown to a two-wheeled pleasure cart only with a foot basket. Ponies enter the ring to the right at a Country Pleasure Trot. To be shown both ways of the ring at a Walk, Country Pleasure Trot, and Extended Trot. Ponies to be lined up in the center of the ring, stand quietly and rein back.

Classic Country Pleasure Driving Stake-

Judged the same as Country Pleasure Driving. To qualify, ponies must have been shown in the Classic Country Pleasure Driving Class held during the Show now in progress.

Classic Roadster Driving - Open –

Ponies are shown with a stirrup bike with no basket. The exhibitor must wear racing silks (cap and jacket to match). Ponies are to be shown at the three (3) speeds; the Slow Jog Trot, the Road Gait, and at a full, extended Drive-On Trot. Exhibitors will be entering the ring to the LEFT. Ponies will not be asked to rein back.

Classic Roadster Driving -- Limit

Open to ponies which have not won six (6) First Place ribbons in a Class A competition. Judged the same as the Open Roadster, however headers are optional.

Classic Roadster Driving --Stake –

Judged the same as Open Roadster. To qualify to compete in a Stake, a pony must have been shown in at least one (1) other class of the Roadster Division of the show in progress.

Classic Single Draft Harness Driving -- Open

To be shown to a suitable four-wheeled vehicle, except that a cart may be used for singles. Heavy draft harness with collar, and full hames, breeching and appropriate bit suitable for heavy draft-type harness is required. No one may assist driver in any way (except in the event of any accident), but passengers are permitted. To be shown both ways of the ring at a working trot and a flat-footed walk without undue restraint. To halt, stand quietly, and back readily. To be Judged 60% on manners (in motion and rest) and utilitarian useful performance, 30% on breed type, suitability and conformation, and 10% on appointments (draft type equipment).
